# TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE (Apollo Drone Services) DRONE MAJOR LIMITED

## 1. OUR DETAILS

#### 2. INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 These terms and conditions of use (the "Terms") shall govern your use of our website.

- 7.3.1use of, or inability to use, our website; or
